This term in Year 2 the topic is Everyday Heroes!

The children will be learning what a hero is, and finding out about people from both the past and present who are considered to be heroes! In Science, they will learn that animals (including humans) have offspring which grow into adults, and the importance of exercise, hygiene and eating the right amounts of different types of food and much more!

In Maths the children will be focusing on Place Value, Addition and Subtraction (within 100) and Shape.

In English the children will base their learning around the story 'Traction Man' and non-fiction books about everyday heroes.
